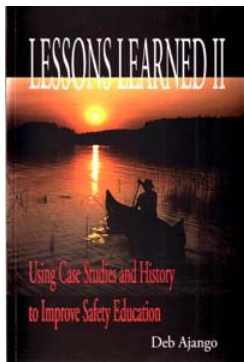

Course Description

The 7-day Wilderness First Responder course is an intensive medical training designed for trip leaders, recreation coordinators, and other outdoor professionals. The course runs from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. each day with the following topics.

- CPR / AED
- Patient Assessment
- Soft-Tissue Injuries
- Musculoskeletal Injuries
- Medical Injuries/Illness
- Environmental Injuries
- Emergency Action & Evacuation Strategies

The class format includes lecture, discussion, scenarios, and case studies.

WFR certification is granted through nationally known Wilderness Medical Associates (WMA).
